OVERVIEW

Cameron Roberts is a litigation associate at Rogers & Hardin. He represents businesses, public entities, and individuals in complex civil litigation and appeals in federal and state courts. Cameron served as a law clerk for Judge Beverly B. Martin of the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit and Chief Judge J. Randal Hall of the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Georgia. He draws on that experience to secure victories for clients on matters of federal practice and procedure and claims brought under many federal statutes.

Cameron graduated, cum laude, from the University of Georgia School of Law, where he served as the editor-in-chief of the Georgia Journal of International and Comparative Law. During law school, he participated in the Jessup International Moot Court Competition and as a pupil in the Lumpkin Inn of Court. He received the Morris B. Abram and Gabriel M. Class Actions
